CONSULTATIVE SESSION

FOR ENTITIES INVOLVED IN RE-SALE / RE-DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC POWER AFTER OBTAINING ONE POINT BULK SUPPLY FROM DISTRIBUTION COMPANIES

All stakeholders, interested / affected persons / parties and the general public are informed that the Authority under Section 20, 21 & 23 of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act 1997 (the NEPRA Act) granted Distribution Licenses to eleven (11) Distribution Companies including (XW-DISCOs) and K-Electric (KEL). The Authority has noticed that certain entities in the Service Territory of Distribution Companies are engaged in distribution & re-sale of electric power.

- 2 The entities involved in this business are categorized as follows:-
 - a) Housing Colonies / Societies.
 - b) Industrial Complex including industrial estates.
 - c) Shopping Malls.
 - d) High Rise Buildings.
3. In order to streamline this arrangement, the Authority has decided to initiate a consultative process amongst all stakeholders before taking any decision. Accordingly, the Authority proposes following issues for discussion and further deliberations.
 - i. Whether to issue distribution license to all Housing Societies / Colonies / Shopping Malls / Industrial Complex / High Rise Buildings engaged in re-sale of electricity before grant of distribution license to DISCOs?
 - ii. Whether it would be appropriate to initiate proceedings for carving out the territories of DISCOs and to grant license all Housing Societies / Colonies / Industrial Complex / High Rise Buildings engaged in re-sale of electricity?
 - iii. Whether the proposed Single Tariff Formula for BTPL consumers can also be applied to the consumers of other Housing Societies / Colonies / Industrial Complex / High Rise Buildings?
 - iv. Whether introduction of a separate category tariff of DISCO to DISCO sale is required and what should be the rationale to determine such tariff under Section 23 of NEPRA Act?
 - v. Whether the definition of Bulk Power Consumer (BPC) be revised in the Act?
