
In the aforesaid Rules, for the "First Schedule" the following shall be substituted namely: -

| Sr. No. | Description of violation   | Fine for the first day of occurrence of violation | Fine* for continue violation beyond the first day |

| 1       | 2  | 3   | 4   |
| 1.      | Generation, transmission or distribution of electric power without obtaining a licence from the Authority. | Upto Rs. 100 Million                              | Upto Rs. 500,000/- per day                        |
| 2.      | Breach of any provision of a licence or authorization.   | Upto Rs. 100 Million                              | Upto Rs. 500,000/- per day                        |
| 3.      | Breach of any provisions of an applicable document.  | Upto Rs. 100 Million                              | Upto Rs. 500,000/- per day                        |
| 4.      | Charging of tariffs not approved by the Authority.   | Upto Rs. 100 Million                              | Upto Rs. 500,000/- per day                        |
| 5.      | Any other violation not expressly provided in these rules of the applicable documents.                     | Upto Rs. 100 Million                              | Upto Rs. 500,000/- per day                        |

\* to be calculated from the date of violation up to the date of payment of sum due, but excluding the period prescribed in the rules during which the proceedings are pending before the Authority up to the date of the final order, including the order in review.
