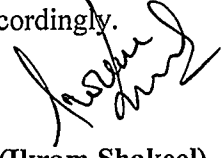

ORDER

1. Hearing in the matter was conducted at NEPRA Regional Office Lahore on 21.08.2026, wherein both parties tendered appearance. At the outset of hearing, the representative for the Petitioner stated that the Respondents have afforded slab benefit against 2,540 accumulated units in compliance with the decision dated 09.06.2026 of this forum; as such, the Petitioner does not press the instant review petition. The representative for the Petitioner further pleaded that the Respondents be directed for recovery of revised bill in four monthly installments keeping in view the financial constraints of the Petitioner. The Respondent's official agreed to facilitate the Petitioner with regard to the plea for installments of revised bill.
2. In view of the above statement, the review petition is disposed of as withdrawn. However, the Petitioner requested for payment of revised bill in four installments, therefore the Respondents may facilitate the Petitioner and the revised bill be recovered in four equal monthly installments along with current bills subject to fulfilment of all codal formalities.
