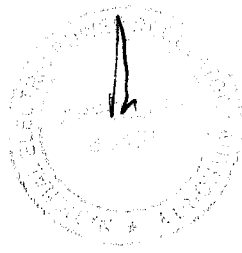

DECISION

1. This decision shall dispose of the appeal filed by K-Electric against the decision dated 22.02.2017 of Provincial Office of Inspection, Karachi Region-I, Karachi (POI).
2. As per facts of the case, the respondent who is a domestic consumer of the appellant K-Electric bearing Ref No. AL-8463480 filed an application before POI on 25.03.2014 and challenged the detection bill of Rs. 25,512/- of 1,331 units for the period 05.07.2012 to 04.01.2013 charged in March 2013.

3. POI vide its decision dated 22.02.2017 disposed of the matter with the conclusion that the detection bill of Rs. 25,512/- for the period 05.07.2012 to 04.01.2013 was unjustified and directed K-Electric to charge the respondent as per actual meter reading. LPS charged to the respondent were also waived off in the aforesaid decision.
4. Through the instant appeal, POI decision dated 22.02.2017 has been challenged by K-Electric under Section 38 (3) of NEPRA Act 1997. After issuing notice, the hearing of the appeal was conducted in Karachi on 16.10.2017 in which both the parties entered their appearance. At the outset of the hearing, representative for K-Electric disclosed that an out of court settlement was reached between the parties as such K-Electric did not intend to proceed further with the appeal. The respondent confirmed the statement of K-Electric. An application regarding amicable settlement inter se the parties and for withdrawal of the appeal was also filed by K-Electric.
5. Foregoing in view, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
