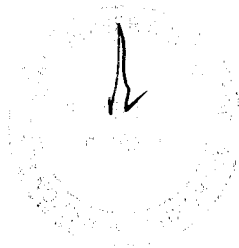

DECISION

1. This decision shall dispose of the appeal filed by K-Electric against the decision dated 22.02.2017 of Provincial Office of Inspection, Karachi Region-I, Karachi (POI) under section 38 (3) of NEPRA Act 1997.
2. As per facts of the case, the respondent who is a domestic consumer of the appellant K-Electric with sanctioned load of 2 kW under tariff A-1R bearing Ref No. AL-846330, filed an application before POI on 25.03.2014 and assailed the detection

bill of Rs. 37,880/- for 2,479 units for the period 06.07.2013 to 07.01.2014 charged in March 2014.

3. The matter was disposed of by POI vide it's decision dated 22.02.2017 whereby the detection bill of Rs. 37,880/-for 2,479 units for the period 06.07.2013 to 07.01.2014 was cancelled along with assessed bills and LPS levied against assessed bill/detection bills.
4. The instant appeal has been filed by K-Electric against POI decision dated 22.02.2017. Notice issued and hearing was conducted on 16.10.2017 wherein both the parties were present. At the outset of hearing, representative for K-Electric averred that an out of court settlement was reached between the parties as such K-Electric did not intend to proceed further with the appeal. The respondent verified the statement of K-Electric.
5. In view of the above, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
