

K. Electric Limited through Mr. Asif Shajer, Deputy Manager (Regulations) of K-Electric Limited (hereinafter referred to as "**the Appellant**") submitted the subject appeal titled "K-Electric Limited Vs Mr. Siddiq Ahmed" received in this office on 23.04.2019 (PUC). The subject appeal has been filed by K. Electric Limited against the decision of the Provincial Office of Inspection/Electric Inspector regarding Complaint of Mr. Siddiq Ahmed. The instant appeal has been filed under Section 38(3) of NEPRA Act against the decision dated 25.03.2019 of the Provincial Office of Inspection/Electric Inspector, Karachi Region-II, Karachi.

2. The appeal submitted by the appellant has initially been examined by the Registrar Office to check the compliances of the Regulations. The information/documents received so far are listed on checklist (**Annex-I**). The same is submitted for information & further examination by the SA (CAD), the Convener of Appellate Board.

4. Pursuant to the Authority's approved functional process (ref: MOM of RM 13-187) for processing the appeals the steps from Regulation 3 to Regulation 10(1) of Regulations has been completed. As per the said functional process, after preparation of initial checklist, Registrar Office has to forward the case to the CAD for comments/recommendations regarding registration of the appeal (step ii of functional process in respect of Regulation 10(1) of the Regulations). However, CAD vide ION dated 15.01.2018 (F/A) has requested that the appeals may directly be referred by Registrar Office to the Appellate Board; the said recommendation of CAD is reproduced as under:

"It is apprised that pursuant to Regulation 10(2) of NEPRA (Procedure for Filing of Appeals) Regulations, 2012 (the Regulations), the Registrar shall register an appeal and allot a serial number after due scrutiny. As per practice in vogue, the Registrar refer the appeals to Consumer Affairs Department (CAD) for comments/recommendation with respect to whether the appeal be allotted a number or otherwise. Thereafter, the case/appeal is referred back to the Registrar to allot a number, and then the Registrar forward the case/appeal to the Appellate Board through CAD.

It is suggested that since the Appellate Board now has sufficient support staff to scrutinize the appeals filed under the Regulations, therefore, in future, the appeals may be directly forwarded /referred to the Appellate Board for further processing."

5. In view of the above, the case file along with revised checklist may be forwarded for comments/recommendations of SA (CAD), the Convener of Appellate Board, that whether the appeal is in order to allot a number by Registrar Office or otherwise, please.


11. Accordingly, endorsement as per **Form-B** of the Regulations has been prepared and is placed for the signature by the Registrar.
