DECISION

1. As per facts of the case, the respondent, who is an industrial consumer of LESCO bearing Ref No.24-11421-0358130-U approached the Provincial Office of Inspection (POI) on 25.09.2018 and challenged the detection bill of Rs.3,722,451/- for 208,360 units for the period January 2016 to March 2018 charged by LESCO. The application of the respondent was decided by POI vide its decision dated 16.04.2019, wherein the above detection bill was declared as null & void and LESCO was directed to revise the bills w.e.f November 2016 and onwards on the basis of consumption of November 2015 and onwards as per clause 4.4 of CSM.

2. Through the instant appeal, POI decision dated 16.04.2019 has been impugned by LESCO before NEPRA. After issuing notice, hearing of the appeal was held in NEPRA Regional Office Lahore on 30.12.2020 which was attended by learned counsel for LESCO and no one appeared for the respondent. At the outset of the hearing, learned counsel for LESCO stated that the dispute was settled amicably between the parties and requested for the disposal of the appeal, accordingly.

3. In view of the above mutual settlement, the appeal is disposed of.
