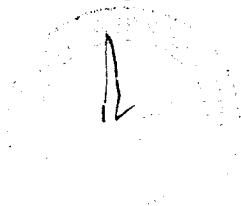

DECISION

1. As per facts of the case, the respondent, who is a domestic consumer of MEPCO bearing Ref No.06-15171-5922700 initially filed an application before NEPRA and assailed the detection bill of Rs.182,368/- for the period July 2013 to February 2017 (44 months) charged on the recommendation of audit department vide Audit Note No.910 dated 11.08.2017. NEPRA vide letter dated 01.03.2018 referred the matter to the Provincial Office of Inspection (POI) for further adjudication. POI vide decision dated 30.08.2018 disposed of the complaint of the respondent and declared the detection bill of Rs.182,368/- for the period July 2013 to February 2017 as void.

2. MEPCO was aggrieved with the POI decision dated 30.08.2018, hence approached NEPRA through the appeal No.190/POI-2019. After issuing the notice, hearing of the appeal was conducted in NEPRA Regional Office Multan on 29.10.2020 which was attended by learned counsel along with SDO MEPCO and no one entered an appearance for the respondent. At the outset of the hearing, learned counsel for MEPCO disclosed that the dispute of detection bill of Rs.182,368/- was amicably settled between the parties as such MEPCO do not intend to proceed with the appeal. In support of his contention, learned counsel for MEPCO submitted an application dated 29.10.2020 for withdrawal of the appeal.
3. In consideration of the above mutual settlement between the parties, the appeal is disposed of.
