DECISION

This decision shall dispose of the complaint filed by M/s ZB Steel Furnaces through Mr. Mustafa Kamal Advocate (hereinafter referred to as the "Complainant" or "Petitioner") against Gujranwala Electric Power Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent" or "GEPCO"), under Section 39 of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 (hereinafter referred to as the "NEPRA Act").

- 2. Brief facts of the case are that the Complainant filed a complaint before NEPRA received on April 04, 2025 regarding charging of fixed charges by GEPCO in the bill issued for the month of April 2025, May 2025 and onwards in the light of tariff determination issued by NEPRA on July 11, 2024 and requested that the said tariff determination may be declared illegal alongwith revision of bill. Subsequently the Complainant filed a W.P. No. 36829/2025 before Honorable Lahore High Court, Lahore and requested the Court to direct NEPRA for early disposal of the Complaint. The Court vide order dated June 18, 2025 directed NEPRA to decide the pending complaint expeditiously.
- 3. The matter was taken up with GEPCO for submission report and a hearing was held at NEPRA Head Office, Islamabad. The hearing was attended by GEPCO official(s) only whereas the Complainant remained absent. During the hearing and scrutiny of documents i.e. complaint/petition it was observed that the Complainant has challenged the tariff determination dated July 11, 2024 of the Authority and consequently fixed charges imposed by GEPCO in the electricity bill(s).

It is clarified that remedy against the determination/order/decision of the NEPRA Authority is available under Section 12(G) of the NEPRA Act before the Appellate Tribunal, (NEPRA) and not under Section-39 of the said Act. In view thereof, this complaint is not maintainable and is disposed of. Further proceedings in the matter are being closed by this office.
