Subject: DECISION IN THE MATTER OF COMPLAINT FILED BY MR. WAHEED UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE REGULATION OF GENERATION, TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC POWER ACT, 1997 AGAINST K-ELECTRIC LIMITED REGARDING DETECTION BILL (CONSUMER NO. LC-361531 & LC-900065)

Reference is made to the complaint regarding the subject matter.

- 2. Scrutiny of the record provided by both the parties i.e. (KE and the Complainant) and arguments during the hearing reveals that KE has charged the detection bill amounting to Rs.124,811/-, Rs.122,199/- & Rs.68,404/- on the connection having consumer no. LC-361531 and Rs.126,586/- & Rs.41,294/- on the connection having consumer no. LC-900065 without proper justification. Moreover, KE has charged the detection bill amounting to Rs.113,624,/- on the connection having consumer no. LC-900065on the basis of sufficient evidence.
- 3. Foregoing in view, KE is directed as follows:
 - a) Withdraw the detection bills amounting to Rs. 124,811/-, Rs. 122,199/-&,Rs.68,404/- charged to the Complainant on LC-361531.
 - b) Withdraw the detection bills amounting to Rs. 126,586/- & Rs. 41,294/charged to the Complainant on LC-900065.

- c) The detection bill amounting to Rs.113,624,/- charged to the Complainant charged to the Complainant on LC-900065 does not merit to be proceeded & the same is liable to be paid.
- 4. A report in this regard be submitted within twenty (20) days, positively.
