




**Subject:** COMPLAINT FILED BY SINDH ECONOMIC ZONES MANAGEMENT COMPANY, GOVERNMENT OF SINDH (SEZMC) THROUGH CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER (SEZMC) UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE REGULATION OF GENERATION, TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC POWER ACT 1997 AGAINST SEPCO REGARDING REQUEST FOR APPROPRIATE AND COMPETITIVE TARIFF FOR KHAIRPUR SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONE (KSEZ).

Reference is made to the complaint filed by Sindh Economic Zones Management Company (SEZMC), and correspondence made regarding the subject matter.

2. NEPRA, through its letter dated September 24, 2025 conveyed detailed observations on the complaint submitted by the Sindh Economic Zones Management Company (SEZMC) whereby it was highlighted that the sanctioned load for Khairpur Special Economic Zone (KSEZ) is 415 kW and the actual requirement stands at around 2 MW, with an anticipated future need of up to 5 MW. It was further emphasized that Special Economic Zones are established to facilitate industrial development and that distribution companies must extend full support, avoiding unnecessary delays and procedural hurdles. In this regard, SEPCO was directed to process and conclude the SEZMC's request for load extension as quickest possible.

3. Subsequently, a hearing was held on November 11, 2025 at NEPRA Head Office, Islamabad which was attended by both the parties i.e. SEZMC and SEPCO. During the hearing the matter was discussed in detail. The representative of SEPCO raised concerns regarding the non-compatibility of the existing distribution network within KSEZ and indicated that certain technical interventions may be required to ensure system readiness



for enhanced load. The SEPCO was directed vide letter dated November 12, 2025 to carry out survey of the distribution network along with representative of the Complainant i.e. SEZMC and submit report within ten (10) days. However, the requisite report is still awaited. At present KSEZ is operating at one point supply and SEPCO has provided connection under A2 Commercial tariff whereas there is no commercial activity at site. The nature of load at KSEZ is of mixed load i.e. Tube-wells, street lights, residential buildings, residencies, administrative blocks, mosque, etc.

4. Since a policy level proposal of O&M agreement for SEZ(s) is under consideration therefore, SEPCO is directed to provide electricity to SEZMC on C-Tariff, without any further delay, having mixed load inside the KSEZ. Further, SEPCO may carry out a comprehensive technical assessment of the distribution network within KSEZ and identify any discrepancies, shortcomings, or compatibility issues, if any, that could affect safe and reliable power supply and intimate to this office for further rectification by KSEZ. SEPCO may obtain an undertaking from KSEZ to abide by the directions/ policy of NEPRA as and when finalized.


