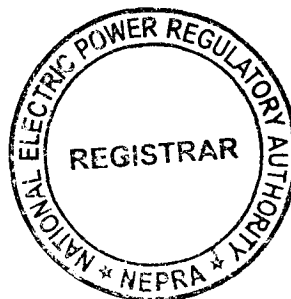



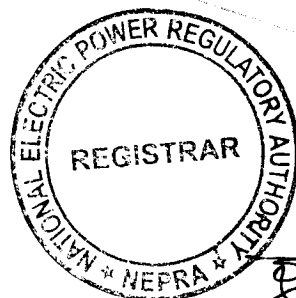
**Determination of Authority**  
**in the Matter of Licensee Proposed Modification (LPM) of**  
**Kohinoor Mills Limited for its Distribution Licence**

**November 29, 2013**  
**Application No. LAD-20**

The Authority granted a Generation Licence (No. SGC/007/2001, dated December 08, 2001) to Kohinoor Mills Limited (KML), a Small Power Producer (SPP) for its Thermal Generation Facilities located at 8-KM Manga Raiwind Road, District Kasur in the Province of Punjab.

(2). Further, the Authority also granted a Distribution Licence (No. 15/DL/2006, dated November 23, 2006) to Kohinoor Mills Limited (KML), as it was supplying to a Bulk Power Consumer in the name of Kohinoor Weaving Mills Limited-Unit No. 2 (KWML), through an Underground Cable located on Public Property.

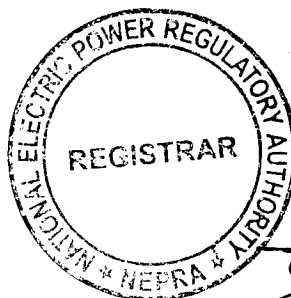
(3). Later on, KML informed that it plans re-routing the underground cable passing through the property of a third party and sought permission in this regard. KML was informed that the proposed re-routing of cable would require an LPM to the Distribution Licence. Further, KML would also require a "No Objection" from LESCO being the host DISCO. In the light of the said directions of the Authority, KML through its correspondence of May 29, 2007 submitted an LPM in the Distribution Licence as stipulated in Regulation 10 of NEPRA Licensing (Application & Modification Procedure) Regulations, 1999/the Regulations.



(4). The Registrar published the communicated LPM October 03, 2007 in one English and one Urdu daily newspapers, seeking comments of general public and other stakeholders, Further, apart from the notice in the press, separate notices were also sent to experts, government ministries and representative organization etc, inviting their views and comments. In response to the said and subsequent correspondence with relevant stakeholders, no response was received from LESCO (i.e. Host DISCO).

(5). The Authority considered the matter in its Regulatory Meeting (08-058), held on February 27, 2008 and agreed in principle to the communicated LPM. The Authority further observed that the communicated LPM of KML would also require a Modification in the Distribution Licence of LESCO for accommodating the proposed re-routing. In view of this, it was decided to initiate an Authority Proposed Modification (APM). Accordingly, the proposed APM was communicated to LESCO directing it to either agree or disagree to the APM. In reply to this, LESCO did not agree to APM. In view of the disagreement of LESCO to the proposed APM, the Authority convened a public hearing in the matter which was held on May 13, 2008. After hearing the concerned parties (i.e. LESCO and KML), the Authority directed looking into different option to resolve the matter amicably.


(6). LESCO through its letter of April 29, 2013 informed that KML has obtained a connection from it for supplying to KWML. Therefore, it does not require any re-routing any more. KML through its letter of June 03, 2013 has confirmed the position taken by LESCO and it does not require the re-routing of the 11 KV currently.




(7). The Authority considered the matter in its Regulatory Meeting (RM-13-373), held on June 27, 2013 and observed that the very purpose for which LPM was filed by KML and consequently APM was initiated, has been lost. Therefore, the Authority closed the proceedings of the LPM of KML for its Distribution Licence.



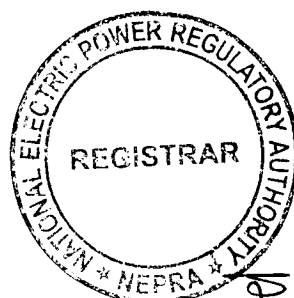
  
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
