<u>Determination of the Authority</u> in the Matter of Request of Solis Charlie Energy (Private) Limited for Transfer of Generation Licence

February 19[#], 2024
Case No. LAG-467

The Authority granted a Generation Licence (No. SGC/139/2020, dated September 09, 2020) to Solis Charlie Energy (Private) Limited (SCEPL) in terms of Section-14B of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 (the "NEPRA Act"). The above licence envisaged setting up two (02) different Photo Voltaic (PV) based generation facilities at D.I. Khan Cantonment (2.00 MW_P) and Kohat Cantonment (1.50 MW_P), supplying to the said entities as Bulk Power Consumers [BPC(s)].

- (2). In consideration of the above, SCEPL submitted that it was not able to execute the project due to various reasons beyond its control and resultantly its contract was cancelled and GHQ re-initiated the process of bidding. Accordingly, GHQ awarded the work to Foundation Solar Energy (Private) Limited (FSEPL) for executing the same project. Further, in order to save time and effort already made, the parties i.e. SCEPL and GHQ agreed that the above mentioned existing licence be got transferred in favor of FSEPL in terms of the relevant provisions of the NEPRA Act.
- (3). In view of the above, SCEPL submitted a request for transfer of its above mentioned Generation Licence in favor of FSEPL as stipulated under Section-27 of the NEPRA Act. The Authority considered the said request of SCEPL and observed that in terms of Section-27 of the NEPRA Act, a licensee or a registered person, as the case may be shall not, surrender, assign or transfer its licence or registration to any person, without its prior approval. In consideration of the said, the Authority has observed that FSEPL is the

subsidiary of Fauji Foundation, a conglomerate involved in different projects relating to Power Sector. FSEPL is a company incorporated in 2014, which has installed 23.81 MW of PV projects and plans to install 45.50 MW in near future. In addition to the above, recently the Authority has also approved the grant of generation licence to FSEPL of its five (05) B2B applications with a cumulative capacity of around 5.55 MW.

(4).In consideration of the above, the Authority considers that FSEPL has adequate financial and technical resources and experience in setting up of the PV based solar based generation facilities therefore, the transfer of generation licence will have no negative/adverse impact on the execution of the project. In view of the said, the Authority hereby allows the transfer of the Generation Licence (No. SGC/139/2020, dated September 09, 2020) in favor of FSEPL. The transfer of Generation Licence will be subject to the provisions contained in the NEPRA Act, relevant rules and regulations framed there under. The changes in the Generation Licence subsequent to the transfer, are annexed to this determination.
