Decision of the Authority in the Matter of Monthly Adjustment of Power Purchase Price (PPP) for Islamabad Electric Supply Company Limited (IESCO)

The Authority considered IESCO's request for monthly adjustment of power purchase price (PPP) variation for the month of April 2009 pursuant to paragraph II of the order of the Authority dated 23rd August 2008,, notified by the Federal Government vide SRO 959(I)/2008. According to the information/evidence placed before the Authority, the actual PPP for the month of April 2009, charged to IESCO by Central Power Purchasing Agency (CPPA), was Rs. 6.1705/kWh. The Authority observed that in April 2009 CPPA charged a substantial amount of Rs. 2.685 billion in energy charge and Rs. 683 million in the capacity charge on account of previous months' adjustment. According to the information provided by CPPA, the major component of this adjustment pertain to markup on delayed payment to IPPs which was Rs. 2.495 billion in energy charge and Rs. 413.24 million in capacity charge. The Authority considers that the markup on delayed payment to IPPs is not covered under monthly power purchase price adjustment mechanism and needs to be considered separately. The Authority has, therefore, decided not to allow Rs. 2.908 billion on account of markup on delayed payment to IPPs.

The Authority hereby directs CPPA to revise the invoices for the month of April 2009 accordingly. After excluding the impact of markup on delayed payment, the actual PPP has been worked out Rs. 5.7051/kWh, which is Rs. 0.2565/kWh higher than the reference PPP of Rs. 5.4486/kWh. After incorporating the impact of target distribution losses of 11%, the required upward per unit adjustment in the determined tariff has been assessed as Rs. 0.29(Annex I). This adjustment shall apply to all consumer categories except life line residential consumers.

Islamabad Electric Supply Company Limited Adjustment for Power Purchase Price For the Month of April 2009

$$\Delta PPP = \pm \frac{\left(PPP_{(Act)} - PPP_{(Ref)}\right)}{\left(1 - L\right)}$$

Where:

△PPP is the variation in Power Purchase Price including fuel price variation in terms of Rs./kWh purchased occurred in a month against the reference PPP.

PPP (Act) is the actual PPP (Rs. 5.7051/kWh purchased for April 2009) during the month for which the adjustment is required to be made.

PPP (Ref) is the reference power purchase price (PPP) of Rs. 5.4486/kWh.

Lis the target losses which are 11% for FY 2008-09.

Replacing values in the formula we get,

$$\Delta PPP = (5.7051-5.4486)/(1-11%)$$

$$\Delta PPP = (+) Rs. 0.2882/kWh$$

According to the decision of the Authority, the impact of variation in the power purchase price shall not be passed on to the lifeline residential consumers. The ratio of lifeline consumers in IESCO's total sales is around 2.11%. The adjusted ΔPPP shall be calculated as under:

PPP = 0.2882/(1-2.11%)
 Δ PPP = (+) Rs. 0.29/kWh

The impact of change in the power purchase price will be calculated according to the following formula:

PPP Adjustment =
$$\pm \Delta PPP \times U(C)$$

Where:

U(C) are units consumed by the consumer during the month for which the adjustment is required to be made.
