

**DECISION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC POWER REGULATORY AUTHORITY
IN THE MATTER OF TARIFF PETITION FILED BY
KANDIAH HYDROPOWER (PVT.) LTD.**

Kandiah Hydropower (Pvt.) Ltd. (hereunder referred to as the "Petitioner" or "KHPL") filed a Tariff Petition (hereinafter referred to as the "Petition") before the National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") pursuant to Rule 3 of the NEPRA (Tariff Standards & Procedure) Rules, 1998 (hereinafter referred to as the "Tariff Rules") for determination of Generation Tariff for its 545 MW Kaigah hydropower project envisaged to be set up at Kandiah River in Kohistan District, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The Authority admitted the Petition on September 27, 2018 in accordance with sub-rule 3 of rule 4 of the Tariff Rules.

2. Subsequent to the admission of the Petition, comments dated October 02, 2018 were received from the Private Power Infrastructure Board (PPIB) whereby it was confirmed by the PPIB that it does not recognize KHPL as the Project Company for the subject petition. Furthermore, the PPIB vide letter dated November 15, 2018 terminated the LOI of Kaigah project issued on February 11, 2008 to Assmandal Trading Company LLC (ATC).

3. In view of the aforementioned facts of the case the Authority feels that the Petition can no longer be entertained and, therefore, has decided to dismiss the same.

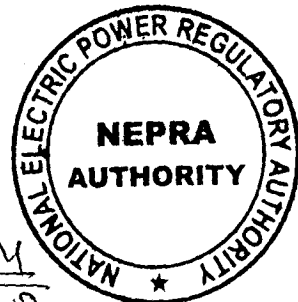


