Please find enclosed the decision of the Authority (01 page) on account of interim fuel price adjustment of Atlas Power Ltd. (APL) in Case No. NEPRA/TRF-68/APL-2007.

2. Summary of decision is:

- Interim adjustment subject to adjustment on the basis of revised or modified mechanism on account of fuel price variation for furnace oil procured during the months of April, May and June, 2009 for the purpose of testing to achieve COD.



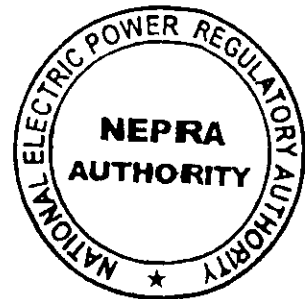
4. Please note that only revised schedule of tariff is required to be notified in the official Gazette.

4. Decision


Having considered all the relevant aspects of the case the Authority has decided:




