


DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF ADJUSTMENT OF CALORIFIC VALUE FOR NISHAT POWER LIMITED (NPL)

- 1. According to the Decision of the Authority dated 3rd June 2011 in the matter of calorific value adjustment mechanism, the calorific value (CV) of furnace oil is subject to adjustment on actual basis. The following was decided by the Authority:
 - i) to fix 18,364 Btu/lb as reference CV with no adjustment below the minimum limit agreed in the FSA.
 - ii) to direct the IPPs to maintain and submit, annually a detailed record of consignment wise CV of the oil received and consumed by IPPs for power generation for its adjustment with respect to reference calorific value duly supported with the copies of test reports certified by the fuel supplier.
- 2. The Authority vide letter dated February 7, 2017, communicated to IPPs that the Authority has decided to carry out the CV adjustments of the concerned Power Plants on quarterly basis in future.
- 3. Accordingly, Nishat Power Limited (NPL) submitted consignment wise record of the fuel consumed along with supplier's certificates of calorific value. On the basis, thereof, NPL worked out Rs. 2,147,381 (Rupees Two Million One Hundred Forty Seven Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty One Only) receivable from the power purchaser for the period of January-March 2017 on account of variation in calorific values.
- 4. The data provided by NPL was analyzed. Actual amount, payable by Power Purchaser to NPL works out to be **Rs. 2,147,381** (Rupees Two Million One Hundred Forty Seven Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty One Only) for the period of January-March 2017 on account of adjustment of actual monthly average CV against the reference CV of 18,364 Btu/lb. The detailed calculations are attached as **Annex-I**.

Order

5. The Central Power Purchasing Agency Guarantee Limited is hereby direct to pay Rs. 2,147,381 (Rupees Two Million One Hundred Forty Seven Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty One Only) to NPL on account of adjustment of calorific value for the period January-March 2017.









6. The above order of the Authority along with Annex-I shall be notified in the official gazette in accordance with the provision of Section 31(4) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act 1997.
