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


**Decision of the Authority in the Matter of Motion for Leave for Review filed by Lucky Cement Limited Against Decision of the Authority dated September 30, 2020 in the Matter of Approval of Power Acquisition Request filed by K-Electric for Purchase of 1-6 MW Power from Lucky Cement Limited**


- 1.1. K-Electric Limited (KE) filed Power Acquisition Request (PAR) on March 03, 2020 for purchase of 1-6 MW from Lucky Cement Limited (LCL) under the Interim Power Procurement (Procedure & Standards) Regulations, 2005 (IPPR-2005) for onward supply to DHA City Karachi (DHCK). The PAR was approved by the Authority vide its decision dated September 30, 2020.
- 1.2. LCL being aggrieved of the above decision of the Authority filed a motion for leave for review on October 29, 2020 on following grounds:
  - i. Fuel Cost Component (FCC)
  - ii. Return on Equity (ROE)
  - iii. Financial cost component
  - iv. Fixed & Variable O&M
- 1.3. Hearing in the matter was held on December 07, 2020 which was attended by the representatives of LCL, KE and DHCK. During the hearing, the Authority directed LCL to provide operational data of the plant to support the requested efficiency numbers. Accordingly, a questionnaire was sent to LCL vide letter dated December 28, 2020. Two reminders in the matter were also sent on March 9, 2021 and June 21, 2021. LCL submitted its response vide letter dated July 01, 2021.


**Decision**


- 1.4. The Authority is of the view that in terms of Regulation 3(2) of the NEPRA (Review Procedure) Regulations, 2009, a motion seeking review of any order or decision of the Authority is competent only upon discovery of new and important matter of evidence or on account of some mistake or error apparent on the face of record or for any other sufficient reasons. The perusal of the impugned decision sought to be reviewed, motion for leave for review and information provided vide letter dated July 1, 2021 indicated that all material facts and issues were examined in detail and there is no occasion to amend or modify the impugned decision. Therefore, the Authority is convinced that the review motion shall not result in the withdrawal or modification of the impugned decision; hence the same is hereby dismissed.
