#### ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT OF INSURANCE COMPONENT OF NATIONAL POWER PARKS MANAGEMENT COMPANY (PRIVATE) LIMITED FOR ITS POWER PROJECT AT HAVELI BAHADAR SHAH FOR THE 4<sup>TH</sup> AGREEMENT YEAR.

Pursuant to the Authority's decision dated May 20, 2020 notified vide S.R.O. No. 484(1)/2021 in the matter of Review Motion against the COD decision, the insurance component of tariff is subject to annual adjustment as per actual cost with maximum of 1% of EPC cost. NPPMCL-HBS requested to revise the insurance components of Rs. 0.1197/kW/h & Rs. 0.1364/kW/h on the basis of insurance premium amount of Rs. 1,273,334,197/- for RLNG & HSD, respectively, for 4<sup>th</sup> agreement year. Subsequently, NPPMCL-HBS vide dated October 14, 2022 revised its request and requested to allow the insurance cost components of Rs. 0.1387/kW/h & Rs. 0.1581/kW/h on the basis of insurance premium of Rs. 1,476,002,059/-for the period of May 9, 2021 to June 30, 2022. NPPMCL-HBS in support provided copies of insurance policies, premium invoices and cheques. The details of insurance premium paid are provided hereunder:

- 2. As per the approved mechanism, NPPMCL-HBS is allowed to adjust its insurance component annually on the basis of Actual Premium or 1% of the EPC cost at exchange rate prevailing on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the insurance coverage period, whichever is lower. 1% of the EPC cost is equal to US 5.837 million. On the basis of prevailing exchange rates of PKR 153.10/US\$ and PKR 158.30/US\$ for the period from May 9, 2021 to June 30, 2022, the maximum limit for insurance cost works out PKR 1,053,766,428.
- 3. The requested insurance premiums works out 1.61% of the approved EPC cost for the period from May 9, 2021 to June 30, 2022 and is higher than the approved limit of insurance cost. Therefore, as per the approved mechanism insurance premium as per capped limit is considered for adjusted insurance components.
- 4. Accordingly, on the basis of information/documents provided by NPPMCL-HBS and in accordance with the Schedule VIII of Power Purchase Agreement, the insurance component of capacity charge part of tariff has been revised. The revised insurance components of capacity charge part of tariff indicated hereunder shall be immediately applicable:
