DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF ADJUSTMENT/INDEXATION IN INSURANCE COMPONENT OF CAPACITY CHARGE PART OF TARIFF FOR HALMORE POWER GENERATION COMPANY LIMITED (HPGCL)

1. Pursuant to the decision of the Authority dated January 8, 2014 in the matter of tariff adjustments at Commercial Operations Date (COD), decision of the Authority dated November 6, 2014 read with corrigendum dated December 4, 2014 in the matter of Motion for Leave for Review regarding Halmore Power Generation Company Limited (HPGCL), the insurance component of capacity charge part of tariff is subject to adjustment as per actual. HPGCL vide its letter No. HPGCL/TRF/Q1/033 dated November 18, 2021 requested to approve insurance component of Rs. 0.2442/kW/h for the period June 15, 2021 to June 14, 2022. HPGCL in support of its request provided copies of premium invoices, insurance policies and quotations from three different insurance companies for current year i.e. 2021-2022. HPGCL also provided payment evidences of previous year i.e. 2020-2021 and detail of No Claim Bonus. The details of requested insurance cost net of Federal Exercise Duty is as under:

- 2. As per the approved mechanism, HPGCL is allowed to adjust its insurance component annually on the basis of actual premium or 1.35% of EPC cost whichever is lower. Accordingly, 1.35% of the EPC cost i.e. US\$ 2,332,733 translates into Rs. 365,539,183 at the exchange rate of Rs. 156.7/USD prevailing on the 1st day of the insurance coverage period. The requested insurance premium works out 1.65% of EPC cost at the prevailing exchange rate and is higher than the approved limit. The Authority has decided to approve maximum insurance premium of Rs. 365,539,183 for the period June 15, 2021 to June 14, 2022.
- 3. In accordance with Schedule VIII of the Power Purchase Agreement and on the basis of maximum insurance premium of Rs. 365,539,183, the insurance component has been revised. The revised insurance component of capacity charge part of tariff indicated hereunder shall be immediately applicable:
