





**DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF ADJUSTMENT IN INSURANCE COMPONENT OF TARIFF OF
ZORLU ENERGY PAKISTAN LIMITED**

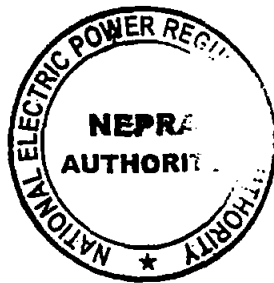
The Authority issued its decision No. NEPRA/R/ADG(Trf)/TRF- 169/ZEPL-2011/27948-27950 dated June 03, 2021 in the matter of adjustment in Insurance component of tariff of Zorlu Energy Energy Pakistan Limited (ZEPL) for the period from December 02, 2018-December 31, 2019.


2. ZEPL vide letter dated March 22, 2022 has requested to approve the above insurance amount in Rs./kWh terms, as the same is required by Central Power Purchasing Agency Guarantee Limited (CPPA-G) for the claim of the payment.
3. Accordingly, the insurance tariff component of the insurance amounts allowed in the above referred decision is reflected in the Annex-I, attached to this decision. The Annex-I is to be notified in the official gazette, in accordance with the provision of Section 31(7) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997.
4. CPPA-G to ensure that all the payments are consistent with tariff determination.



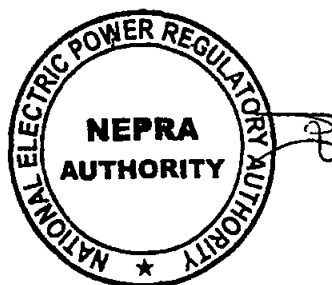
