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DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF ADJUSTMENT IN THE INSURANCE COMPONENT FOR THE 147 MW PATRIND HYDROPOWER PROJECT OF STAR HYDROPOWER LIMITED

- Pursuant to the Authority's Determination in case No.NEPRA/R/SA(Tariff)TRF-172/SHPL-2011/19480-19482 dated July 29, 2020, notified vide S.R.O. 962/(I)/2021 dated July 29, 2021, in the matter of adjustment at commercial operation date, the insurance component is required to be adjusted annually as per actual incurred prudent costs, subject to a maximum of 1.35% of the EPC cost, on annual basis upon production of authentic documentary evidence.
- CPPA (G) forwarded the request of SHPL for indexation of insurance components on annual basis for the period starting from November 08, 2022, to November 07, 2023.
- It was also noted that the Marine Hull insurance has been claimed by SHPL as part of operational insurance without any breakup. According to the scheduled 8 part II (operational period), the scope of the operation period insurance does not include Marine Hull insurance, therefore the same has also been excluded.
- The revised tariff components attached as Annex-I are to be notified in the official gazette, in accordance with the provision of Section 31(7) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act 1997.
