DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF ADJUSTMENT OF CALORIFIC VALUE FROM JANUARY TO MARCH 2023 FOR ATLAS POWER LIMITED (APL).

- According to the decision of the Authority dated June 3, 2011 in the matter of calorific value adjustment mechanism, the calorific value (CV) of furnace oil is subject to adjustment on actual basis. The following was decided by the Authority:
 - i) To fix 18,364 Btu/lb as reference CV with no adjustment below the minimum limit agreed in the
 - ii) To direct the IPPs to maintain and submit, annually a detailed record of consignment wise CV of the oil received and consumed by IPPs for power generation for its adjustment with respect to reference calorific value duly supported with the copies of test reports.
- 2. The IPPs were informed vide letter dated February 7, 2017 that future CV adjustment shall be made on quarterly basis. The IPPs were further directed to get CV tested from Hydrocarbon Development Institute of Pakistan (HDIP) and SGS labs.
- 3. Accordingly, Atlas Power Limited (APL) submitted the consignment wise record of CV for adjustment against the reference CV of 18,364 Btu/lb duly supported with the copies of test reports of Refinery, HDIP and SGS labs for the period covered from January 1, 2023 to March 31, 2023.
- 4. The Authority in its collective and joint wisdom decided with consensus as under; which will be hereafter called as decision of Authority in the matter:-

"The information and CV test reports of labs were analyzed in the light of the documentary evidences provided by APL. Accordingly, an amount of Rs. 6,014,922/- (Six Million Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Two) payable by APL to the power purchaser for the period of January 1, 2023 to March 31, 2023 has been assessed and approved on account of adjustment of actual monthly weighted average CV of HDIP & SGS labs against the reference CV of 18,364 Btu/lb. The detailed calculations are attached as Annex-I.

The Central Power Purchasing Agency (Guarantee) Limited (CPPA-G) is hereby directed to deduct/adjust Rs. 6,014,922/- (Six Million Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Two) against the outstanding amount of APL on account of adjustment of CV for the period of January 1, 2023 to March 31, 2023. CPPA-G is also directed to deduct/adjust the required amount as soon as possible."

5. The above order of the Authority along with Annex-I shall be notified in the official Gazette in accordance with the provision of Section 31(7) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act 1997.
