2. While effecting the Decision, the concerned entities including Central Power Purchasing Agency Guarantee Limited shall keep in view and strictly comply with the orders of the courts notwithstanding this Decision.

**DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF FUEL PRICE ADJUSTMENT
FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2025 FOR LIBERTY POWER TECH LIMITED.**

1. Pursuant to the Authority's decision dated August 17, 2011 in the matter of Tariff Adjustment at Commercial Operation Date (COD) notified vide S.R.O 1016(I)/2011 dated November 10, 2011 and decision of the Authority dated May 11, 2012 in the matter of Motion for Leave for Review regarding Liberty Power Tech Limited (hereinafter "LPTL"), fuel portion of energy charge part of tariff is required to be adjusted on account of variation in fuel price(s).
2. Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), Government of Pakistan through notification No. PL-3(457)/2025-85 dated June 30, 2025 has imposed/notified Petroleum Levy of Rs. 82,077/MT (Rs. 77/liter) and Climate Support Levy of Rs. 2,665/MT (Rs. 2.5/liter) on the sale of furnace oil refined by all the refineries and imports, effective from 1st July 2025. Therefore, LPTL requested RFO fuel prices inclusive of both levies w.e.f. 1st July 2025 and same have been considered.
3. The Authority in its collective and joint wisdom considering all aspects decided with consensus as under; which shall be hereafter called as decision of the Authority in the matter:-

"Based on information and documentary evidence submitted by LPTL, the fuel portion of the energy charge part of LPTL's tariff has been adjusted for variation in furnace oil prices for the month of August 2025."
4. The revised energy charge part of LPTL's tariff relating to fuel indicated hereunder shall be immediately applicable to the units delivered during the month:

5. The above decision of the Authority along with revised fuel cost component attached as Annex-I are to be notified in the Official Gazette in accordance with the provision of Section 31(7) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act 1997.
6. CPPA(G) to ensure that all payments are consistent with the tariff determination(s).

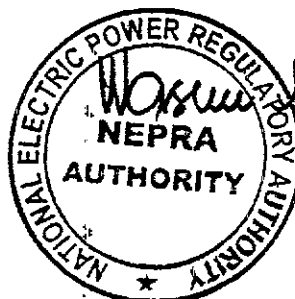

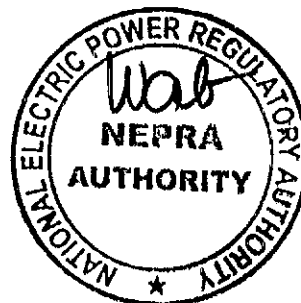
