#### DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF FUEL PRICE ADTUSTMENT FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 2025 FOR NAROWAL ENERGY LIMITED (FORMERLY HUB POWER COMPANY LIMITED-NAROWAL).

- 1. Pursuant to the Order of the Authority dated June 8, 2012 in the matter of tariff adjustment at Commercial Operation Date (COD) notified vide S.R.O 624(1)/2013 dated May 31, 2013 in case No. NEPRA/TRF-92/HUBC0-2008 and decision of the Authority dated November 7, 2014 in the matter of Motion for Leave for Review, regarding Narowal Energy Limited formerly HUB Power Company Limited-Narowal (hereinafter "NEL"), fuel portion of energy charge part of tariff is required to be adjusted on account of variation in fuel price(s).
- 2. NEL through its letter dated December 2, 2024, sought approval for the procurement of RFO from its parent company i.e. Hub Power Company Limited (HUBCO). The Authority allowed NEL for procurement from HUBCO through letter dated March 26, 2025. The extract of letter is hereunder:

"Allowed NEL to procure RFO from HUBCO at the minimum of the delivered price (including freight and applicable OMC Margin) from all operating refineries plus PSO imported RFO price, subject to maximum of average actual price by HUBCO for purchases of subject inventory."

- 3. In accordance with the Authority's decision regarding RFO procurement from HUBCO by NEL, a comparison was made between the delivered prices of all refineries and HUBCO and it is derived that the delivered price of ARL of Rs. 143,300/M.Ton for the 2nd fortnight of June 2025 is the lowest among all-other refineries and HUBCO. Accordingly, the price of Rs. 143,300/M.Ton has been considered for 93.32 M.Tons against NEL's requested price of Rs. 151,224.37/M.Ton purchased during 2<sup>nd</sup> fortnight of June 2025. Regarding purchases for both fortnights of July 2025, NEL requested price of Rs. 151,224.37/M.Ton. Accordingly, the comparison with other refineries was made for each fortnight and the requested price of NEL was established as the lowest price and the same has been considered. No consumption has been made from the subject purchases during the month of July 2025.
- 4. The Authority in its collective and joint wisdom considering all aspects decided with consensus as under; which will be hereafter called as decision of the Authority in the matter:-

"Based on information and documentary evidence submitted by NEL, the fuel portion of the energy charge part of tariff has been adjusted for variation in furnace oil price(s) for the month of July 2025."

5. The revised energy charge part of NEL's tariff relating to fuel indicated hereunder shall be immediately applicable to the unit delivered during the period:
