S.R.O. 1321 (I)/2026.- In pursuance of Proviso-iv of Sub-Section 7 of Section 31 of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 (XL of 1997), NEPRA hereby notifies the Decision of the Authority dated July 27, 2026 along with **Annex-I** in the matter of Fuel Price Adjustment for the month of **June 2026** for Nishat Chunian Power Limited in Case No. NEPRA/TRF-70/NCPL-2007.

2. While effecting the Decision, the concerned entities including Central Power Purchasing Agency Guarantee Limited shall keep in view and strictly comply with the orders of the courts notwithstanding this Decision.

**DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF FUEL PRICE ADJUSTMENT
FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2026 FOR NISHAT CHUNIAN POWER LIMITED.**

1. Pursuant to the Authority's decision dated December 31, 2010 regarding Tariff Adjustment at Commercial Operation Date (COD) notified vide S.R.O. 594(I)/2011 dated June 9, 2011 regarding Nishat Chunian Power Limited (NCPL), fuel portion of energy charge part of tariff is required to be adjusted on account of variation in fuel price(s). NCPL requested fuel cost component of Rs. 57.0181/kWh on the basis of weighted average price of Rs. 289,865.68/M.Ton.
2. Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), Government of Pakistan through notification No. PL3(457)/2025-85 dated June 30, 2025 has imposed/notified Petroleum Levy of Rs. 82,077/MT (Rs. 77/liter) and Climate Support Levy of Rs. 2,665/MT (Rs. 2.5/liter) on the sale of furnace oil refined by all the refineries and imports, effective from July 1, 2025. Therefore, NCPL requested RFO fuel prices inclusive of both levies w.e.f. July 1, 2025 and same have been considered. Furthermore, NCPL requested freight/transportation charges in fuel consumption that exceeded the benchmark rates; therefore, benchmarked transportation charges have been considered.
3. The Authority in its collective and joint wisdom considering all aspects decided with consensus as under; which shall be hereinafter called as the decision of the Authority in the matter:

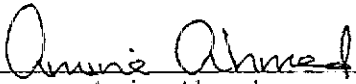
"Based on information and documentary evidence submitted by NCPL, the fuel portion of the energy charge part of NCPL's tariff has been adjusted for variation in furnace oil prices for the month of June 2026."

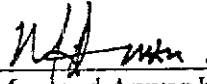
4. The revised energy charge part of NCPL's tariff relating to fuel is indicated hereunder:

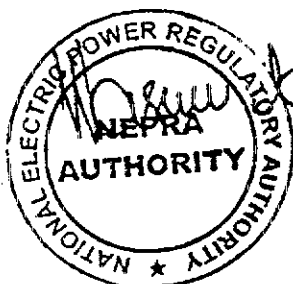
