2. While effecting the Decision, the concerned entities including Central Power Purchasing Agency Guarantee Limited shall keep in view and strictly comply with the orders of the courts notwithstanding this Decision.

**DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF FUEL PRICE ADJUSTMENT
FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2026 FOR NISHTAT POWER LIMITED (NPL).**

1. Pursuant to the Authority's Decision(s) dated October 15, 2010 regarding Tariff Adjustment at Commercial Operation Date (COD) notified vide S.R.O. 1078(I)/2010 dated November 29, 2010 and in the matter of Motion for Leave for Review against the Authority's Decision at COD Stage dated March 22, 2011, fuel portion of energy charge part of tariff is required to be adjusted on account of variation in fuel price(s). NPL requested fuel cost component of Rs. 51.1737/kWh on the basis of weighted average price of Rs. 260,155.18/M.Ton.
2. The Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), Government of Pakistan through notification No. PL-3(457)/2025-85 dated June 30, 2025 has imposed/notified Petroleum Levy of Rs. 82,077/MT (Rs. 77/liter) and Climate Support Levy of Rs. 2,665/MT (Rs. 2.5/liter) on the sale of furnace oil refined by all the refineries and imports, effective from July 1, 2025. Therefore, NPL requested RFO fuel prices inclusive of both levies w.e.f. July 1, 2025 and same have been considered. Furthermore, NPL requested freight/transportation charges in fuel consumption that exceeded the benchmark rates; therefore, benchmarked transportation charges have been considered. Similarly, price of PSO – PRL (April 18, 2026) is more than the ex-refinery + 3.5% OMC margin therefore same has been assessed on the benchmarked price.
3. The Authority in its collective and joint wisdom considering all aspects decided with consensus as under; which shall be hereinafter called as the decision of the Authority in the matter:

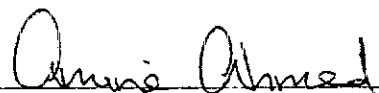
“Based on information and documentary evidence submitted by NPL, the fuel portion of the energy charge part of NPL's tariff has been adjusted for variation in furnace oil price(s) for the month of June 2026.”

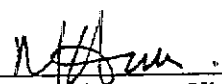
4. The revised energy charge part of NPL's tariff relating to fuel indicated hereunder:

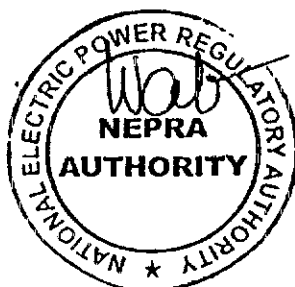
